How to apply for Associate Membership

- The students who have completed CMA examinations together with minimum of three (3) years practical training experiences are eligible to apply for membership.
- Required experience may be obtained whilst taking or after completion of CMA examination.
- Practical Traning Guide (PER) Book can be purchased at CMA office.
- Submitting required documents.
- You have to face an interview (VIVA).
- Pay for requisite Membership Fee.

List of Documents required to submit

- 1. Duly completed membership application form can be downloaded from CMA website
- 2. Duly completed Check List can be downloaded from CMA website.
- 3. Certified photocopies of academic and professional qualifications.
- 4. Certified photocopy of CMA **final results sheet** / certificate
- 5. Logbook each page should be certified by supervising member with company seal.
- 6.Summery sheet
- 7. Updated Signed Resume
- 8. Certificate copy of speech craft certificate
- 9. Certified copy of the CBA



Practical Training

- 3 Years Supervised training under a ACMA/CA/CIMA/ACC/Graduate Accountant
- Practical Experience Requirement
 Application form is at the end of the
 PER Book
- READ the PER BOOK very carefully.
- Need to cover 80% of required skills (Skills and Sub Skills)
- Record in the Per Log Book





- Viva panel will ask questions about your experience based on what you have recorded.
